**On Water**

Educate yourself by obtaining information from public agencies, participating in recreation skills classes, and using your equipment safely. Avoid sensitive areas and shallow waters or near shore areas. Do your part by leaving no trace, properly disposing of fuel, oil, and other waste, restoring damaged areas, and joining a local environmental organization.
